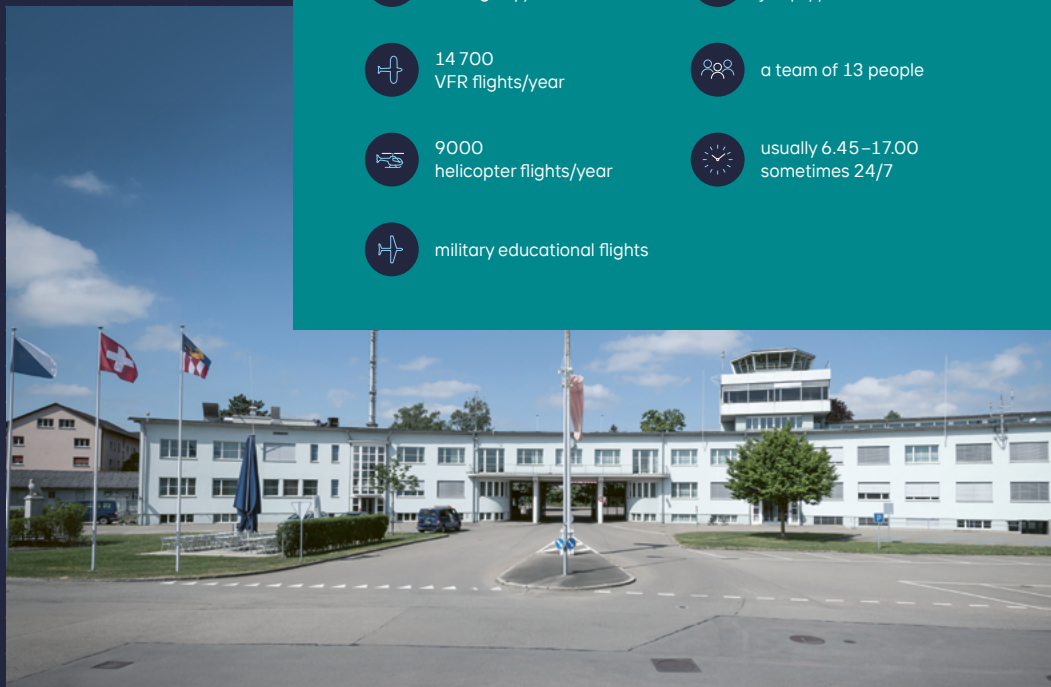

Dübendorf Airport is the only Swiss Air Force base in Eastern Switzerland, and can look back on over 100 years of eventful history. Dübendorf played a crucial role for decades in the development of Swiss aviation, in both commercial and military terms.

In addition to its daily helicopter operations (with Super Puma, Cougar and EC635), the airport is home to various fixed-wing aircraft. These include the Swiss government air transport service's "Federal Council jets" and the special aircraft of Swisstopo, which are used for survey and calibration flights.



The following also operate from Dübendorf:

- Pilatus PC-6 and PC-7 training aircraft
- Police Helicopter of Canton Zurich
- the REGA Swiss Air Rescue company
- the Ju-Air company
- search-and-rescue helicopters of the Swiss Air Force.
