Surrounded by beautiful mountains and nestled in the Magadino plain not far from Lake Maggiore, Locarno airport plays an important role for the region, contributing to the training of pilots and carrying out numerous flight activities. Locarno Airport is located 5 km east of the city.

Its geographical position and the present infrastructure is the ideal place for flight schools: its current state is that of an airfield.

Confirming its function as a military center in Locarno there is the whole spectrum of visual (VFR) and instrumental flight (IFR) activities, from para-troopers to helicopters, from gliders to acrobatic flying and formation flight.



Modernization of the infrastructure is underway, an extension of the asphalt runway is planned and a new ultra-modern instrumental control system is in a final test phase.

Locarno stands firmly in third place in the ranking of regional airports by number of movements and will continue to play a fundamental role in the formation of new pilots for the future.
