Air Traffic Controller in Lugano-Agno

Situated in the Veduggio Valley, the international airport of Lugano-Agno is of critical strategic importance for the region, being the only airport south of the Alps dedicated to civil instrument air traffic. It's an important airport for scheduled flights, private flights, state flights, business and leisure flights as well as being an important point of reference for REGA operations. Apart from the normal instrument flight procedures, the airport of Lugano-Agno also ensures service to the new instrument route networks at low altitude for rescue and military helicopters, which connect the airport and the municipal hospital of Lugano to the rest of Switzerland. Lugano tower manages a wide range of activities, which involve planes,



helicopters and drones as well as gliding activities, aerial work in the region, border patrol flights, military training flights, firefighting and others.

Due to the topography of the terrain the airport is located in a complex airspace, with instrument procedures equally complex and unique worldwide with very steep approaches.
